

IOC committee meeting minutes for June 2006, 1st.

- Biwako camp: leader Yuri

Biwako will be held from Saturday morning July 1st to Sunday July 2nd at Makino Sunny Beach (<http://www.ex.biwa.ne.jp/~takagihama/index.html>). Yuri booked two spaces.
