

IOC committee meeting – September 2006, 2nd.

- IOC autumn camp.

Date: October from the 14th to the 15th. If someone wants to stay on Friday night, he/she has to reserve it by him/herself.

Place: Oosaka furitus sougou seishounen yagai katudou center. We booked 4 lodges at the moment.

Meeting: 10am at Yamashita station (Nose-line).

Deadline: The deadline for sign-up is September 30th. After October 9th, we'll ask some cancel fee. Non-members have to pay before September 30th. If they cancel before October 9th, we'll refund the money with the bank transfer fee deducted.

Cost: 3000yen for members, 3500yen for non-members. Cancel fee is 1000yen for members, 3500yen for non-members.

Food: The committee will buy and prepare the food: Saturday night BBQ and Sunday breakfast and minimum drinks. Yuri and Yuka will buy food on Saturday morning.

Schedule for Saturday:

We will take a Hankyu bus at 10:18 from Yamashita to Nose-no-sato.
